

Dancing Raisins

Do you think raisins can dance? Well, they can. Just try this Dancing Raisins experiment to see raisins bust some cool dance moves.

Things You Need To Make Raisins Dance

- Club soda or any other clear soda like 7 Up or Sprite.
(Use an unopened bottle for best results)
- Raisins
- An empty glass



Steps To Get Raisins To Jump And Dance

- **Step 1:** Separate the raisins, if they're stuck together before starting the experiment. Small or medium raisins are the best dancers in this experiment. Fill the glass with the clear soda, but don't fill it to the brim.
- **Step 2:** Drop a few raisins into the glass. What do you see? Do the raisins sink or float on the surface?
- **Step 3:** Now you just need to sit patiently and observe the glass. You'll notice that the bubbles in the soda attach themselves to the raisins. Slowly, the raisins start floating to the surface. Then, they fall back down and go back up again in a never-ending dance.
