

Popsicle Stick Catapult

Looking for a science project to keep your kids occupied? Then try building this popsicle stick catapult with them.

Things You Need To Build A Popsicle Stick Catapult

- Rubber bands
- Pom poms (or cotton balls)
- Plastic spoon
- Popsicle sticks (or craft sticks)

Steps To Make A Homemade Popsicle Stick Catapult

- **Step 1:** Stack a few popsicle sticks (or craft sticks) and tie them up with a rubber band at each end.
- **Step 2:** Stack 2 more popsicle sticks and tie them up with a rubber band, just on one end. Pull those 2 popsicles sticks apart slightly and place the first stack of popsicle sticks in between.
- **Step 3:** Make sure to tie together the stack of 2 popsicle sticks to only the upper stick. Place your plastic spoon on top of the upper popsicle stick and tie it with a rubber band.
- **Step 4:** Take a cotton ball or pom pom, and place it on the spoon. Your homemade catapult is ready! Hold the catapult in one hand, and use your other hand to pull down your spoon to release the pom pom!
